New research says that drivers aged over 60 have higher crash rates in non problematic operating environments –as in junctions– than drivers of other age groups.

Although elderly drivers present deteriorated

driving abilities, they have proved to be more cautious, to compensate such deficiencies. This way, older drivers avoid engaging in risky behaviours like speeding, passing dangerously or driving under the effects of alcohol.

Such were the conclusions drawn of the study conducted by [University of Granada](#) researchers and recently published in Revista Española de Geriatria y Gerontología, where a comprehensive study was developed on the relationship between driving and age. The authors of this study are **David Cantón Cortés**, **Mercedes Durán Segura** and **Cándida Castro Ramírez**, professors of the Faculty of Psychology of the [University of Granada](#).

In the last decades, a significant increase of crash rates for drivers aged over 60 has been reported. However, and contrary to the general opinion, the study conducted by the [University of Granada](#) revealed that crash rates for this age group are lower than that for younger drivers aged ≤20.

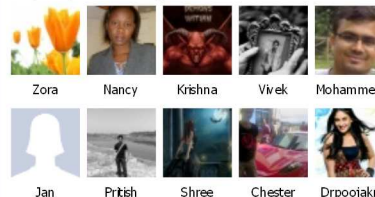
