According to a study conducted at the Department of Pedagogy of the University of Granada, about six out of ten male drug-abusers direct some type of violence against their intimate partners.

Thus, the study revealed a high rate of domestic violence -both physical and psychological- by male drug-abusers against women. The study also detailed the most recurrent forms of abuse, as well as the variables associated to them.

The study revealed that between 6.5 and 72.4pc of the population admits to having committed some form of violence against their partner. The less prevalent conduct was "I forced her to abort against her will" (6.5pc), and the most prevailing being "I show total disregard for her needs, wishes and interests". In addition, 63.5pc of the respondents ensured that they wanted


